

Mission Sheet for the Escape Game in the School Library upon the Sequence First World War Letters and Poems

Your aim is to decipher the encoded letter needed to deactivate the grenade that has been hidden in the trench.

PUZZLE n°1 : *What do we usually hide each year in Springtime ?*

Find the two-words-phrase in one of the poems left by the soldiers somewhere on a table.
